

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Approving FY 1986 Budget for Water Management Committee)

1 WHEREAS, the Water Management Committee has submitted its FY 1986 budget, which
2 budget was previously reviewed and approved by the Budget and Finance
3 Committee; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the budget and has determined that it
5 can and should be funded from the "Papago P.L. 97-293 Trust-Income
6 Account".

8 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve
9 and adopt the attached FY 1986 budget for the Water Management
10 Committee to be funded from the "Papago P.L. 97-293 Trust-Income
11 Account".

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water Management Committee shall submit a
13 progress report within three months of its actions and results in
14 achieving its goals and objectives.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day
17 of November, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1461.0 for; -0- against; 179.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of
20 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
21 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior.
