

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Appointing Committee for Congressional Appropriations Hearings)

RES. NO. 858-85


1 WHEREAS, Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Papago Constitution delegates to and
2 charges the Papago Council with authority to advise Congress and the
3 Secretary of the Interior on all appropriation needs, estimates and
4 priorities for federally funded projects on the Papago Reservation;
5 and

7 WHEREAS, Congressional hearings will soon be scheduled for FY 1987 appropri-
8 ations and it is necessary for this Council to review, prioritize and
9 make recommendations to Congress concerning appropriation needs,
10 estimates and priorities for federally funded projects on the Papago
11 Reservation.

13 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby appoint
14 Harriet Toro, Rosemary Lopez, Max Jose and Angelo Joaquin as a com-
15 mittee, under the chairmanship of Harriet Toro, to collect information,
16 make recommendations to this Council and give testimony before Congress
17 concerning appropriation needs, estimates and priorities for FY 1987
18 federally funded projects on the Papago Reservation.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
21 day of December, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(d) and (e) of Article V of
24 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
25 fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
26 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
27 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
28 of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
29 Council.
