

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing District to carry over perviously allocated
Revenue Sharing Funds to FY 86 Budget)


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has in the past allocated Federal Revenue Sharing
2 Funds to the various districts which were not expended in the year in
3 which it was appropriated; and

4
5 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that each district be
6 authorized to carry over any unexpended Revenue Sharing funds to its
7 FY 86 Revenue Sharing budget.


8 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby author-
9 ize each District, without further approval of the Council to carry
10 over any unexpended Federal Revenue Sharing funds allocated to it in a
11 previous year to its FY 86 Revenue Sharing budget and directs that all
12 pertinent documents be processed through the Tribal Accounting Office.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th
15 day of December, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1577.0 for; 63.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
17 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(d) and (f) of Article V of
18 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
19 fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
