2 did present and review the agenda for January 5, 1987 meeting; and


3 WHEREAS, a request from Councilman Max Jose was made to include resolutions

6 Health report.


7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council

15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




