

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Resolution No. 493-86 to be in closed session)

RES. NO. 02-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did meet on January 5, 1987 and
2 was informed that the Nation's Chairman, Josiah Moore, did veto
3 Resolution No. 493-86 (Process be implemented for removal of Treasurer
4 and Comptroller); and

5 WHEREAS, the Chairperson of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, Harriet
6 Toro, is concerned that the discussion may lead into confidential in-
7 formation which may infringe on the individuals civil rights; and

8 WHEREAS, this issue does concern the Nation's Treasurer and Comptroller; and

9 WHEREAS, such matters in the past has been discussed in a closed session of the
10 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

11 WHEREAS, the two individuals are protected by the Indian Civil Rights Act.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
13 hereby declares that it go into closed session to address the veto of
14 Resolution No. 493-86 (Process be implemented for removal of Treasurer
15 and Comptroller).

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
19 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 636.5 for; 570.5 against; 295.0 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
22 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
