

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Attorney be excluded from Council Session)

RES. NO. 03-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did act to go into closed
2 session to address Resolution No. 493-86 (Process be implemented for
3 removal of Treasurer and Comptroller); and

4 WHEREAS, Virgil Lewis deems it appropriate that the Legal Counsel, Dabney
5 Altaffer, be excluded from the discussion of this matter.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dabney Altaffer, Legal Counsel for the
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation, is hereby directed to leave the Chambers of the
8 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

10 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
11 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
12 390.5 for; 925.0 against; 186.5 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
13 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
14 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
