

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Override veto of Resolution No. 558-86)

RES. NO. 05-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 558-86  
2 to be in compliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act recommending  
3 process; and


4 WHEREAS, upon presentation of the resolution to the Chairman of the Tohono  
5 O'Odham Nation he did disapprove thereof and returning it to the  
6 Council with his objections in accordance with the provisions of  
7 Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Nation; and

8 WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after consider-  
9 ation again voted to pass Resolution No. 558-86.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby  
11 override the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 558-86, by a vote of  
12 two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast.

14 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Council on the  
15 5th day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and by a  
16 vote of 1382.5 for; -0- against; 257.5 not voting; and 02 absent, did override  
17 the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 558-86, pursuant to the powers vested in  
18 the Council by Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono  
19 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and  
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)  
on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
