10 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
11 1247.0 for; 143.5 against; 249.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI and by Section 5 of  
13 Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
14 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
15 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
16 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
