

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Gu Achi District Resolution No. 1286-01)

RES. NO. 08-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, by Resolution No. 8-70,
2 created the Papago Tribal Utility Authority for the purposes of con-
3 structing, maintaining and operating various utility systems in the
4 Tohono O'Odham Nation to be owned wholly by the Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, for the orderly operation of such systems, PTUA requires the use of
6 land to be used for telephone equipment, storage space, warehouse,
7 office site, and other authorized PTUA uses; and


8 WHEREAS, land belonging to the Nation is available for these purposes, and it
9 is in the best interest of the District and Nation to set aside land
10 for PTUA use.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that land in the Gu
12 Achi District, (description attached) be set aside and allocated for
13 PTUA use as described above.


14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should PTUA not begin use of the above described
15 land within twelve (12) months from this date, this resolution shall
16 become null and void.

17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
18 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1455.5 for; 121.5 against; 63.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 of Article XVI of the Constitu-
21 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
22 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




