

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Rules Committee Recommendations)

RES. NO. 101-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council received a report and recommendations by the
2 Rules Committee which addressed the areas of compensation (Council and
3 Committee pay rate), accountability, and Legislative Calendar; and

4 WHEREAS, the Committee in trying to address the problems that surfaced during
5 this transition period, because of the lack of policies in place, de-
6 cided to offer eight (8) recommendation for the Legislative Council to
7 consider; and

8 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee would like to see the recommendations approved so
9 that it may provide a better direction for the Committee to pursue
10 during this fiscal year.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the eight (8)
12 recommendations submitted by the Rules Committee are hereby approved
13 and adopted.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
17 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 910.5 for; 406.0 against; 323.5 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a)(b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
20 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
