(Authorizing travel to Washington for Chairperson &
Vice-Chairman of Water Resource Committee)

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council were informed by the Chairperson of the Water
2 Resource Committee that a meeting has been scheduled for March 10-11,
3 1987 in Washington D.C. with the Bureau of Reclamation to discuss the
4 requirements of the CAP legislation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Committee supports the attendance of the Chair-
7 person and Vice-Chairman of the Committee, because the meeting would
8 provide valuable information that would benefit the whole committee.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approve the travel
10 of Julia Carrillo, Chairperson and Max Jose, Vice-Chairman of the
11 Water Resource Committee to attend the meeting in Washington D.C. with
12 the Bureau of Reclamation.

14 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
15 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 445.0 for; 740.5 against; 454.4 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
18 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
