

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(No appointments be made to Liquor Commission)

RES. NO. 106-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council agenda for March 6, 1987 included the appoint-  
2 ment of the Liquor Commission; and  
3 WHEREAS, a member of the Legislative Council reminded the Council that the  
4 people defeated legalizing liquor through a referendum vote; and  
5 WHEREAS, the action of the Legislative Council in adopting the Ordinance is  
6 contrary to the wishes of the people; and  
7  
8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council later adopted Ordinance No. 05-82 which gave  
9 each of the eleven (11) Districts the option to legalize liquor.  
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council make no appoint-  
11 ments to the Liquor Commission

12 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th  
13 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
14 571.5 for; 767.0 against; 301.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
19 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
