


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Agenda for the March 27, 1987 meeting
2 consisted of the regular business items for the morning session and
3 the Trial of William L. Farrison for the afternoon session; and
4 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council were unable to address items 2, 3, & 4 under
5 the business section of the Agenda during the morning session; and
6 WHEREAS, the items require Council action in order for the proposals to proceed
7 through the proper funding Agencies.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Agenda items
10 for March 27, 1987 be completed.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 27th
12 day of March, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1519.5 for; -0- against; 120.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
16 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
18 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


