- 8 - San Lucy Land Gift Purchase Tax.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Agenda is

16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


