RES. NO. 118-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Agenda for April 6, 1987 includes the vetoed  
2 resolutions for Council action; and


3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council failed to override the vetoed resolutions by  
4 the required two-thirds (2/3); and

5 WHEREAS, the reason cited for its failure to pass is because the motion to  
6 override included all the vetoed resolutions.



8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the vetoed  
9 resolutions be addressed one at a time.

10 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th  
11 day of April 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
12 475.0 for; 617.5 against; 547.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the  
13 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
14 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
15 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
16 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
17 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
