

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Override veto on Resolution No. 91-87)

RES. NO. 119-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 91-87
2 approved the Environmental Protection Agency-Safe Water Drinking Act
3 Proposal; and


4 WHEREAS, upon presentation of Resolution No. 91-87 to the Chairman of the
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation he did disapprove thereof and returning it to
6 the Council with his objections in accordance with the provisions of
7 Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
8 Nation; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after
11 consideration again voted to pass Resolution No. 91-87.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
13 hereby override the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 91-87, by a vote
14 of two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast.

15 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
16 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and by a vote of
17 1192.0 for; 389.5 against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, did override the
18 Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 91-87 pursuant to the powers vested in the
19 Council by Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
20 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved
21 by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
22 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
