## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving amicus curiae brief)

RES. NO. 121-87

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community has filed a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to review the decision of the Arizona Supreme Court in Central Machinery v. State of Arizona, 703 P.2d 843 (Sup. Ct. Ariz. 1986) overruling decisions of both the Superior Court and Court of Appeals to award attorney's fees based on 42 U.S.C. SS1983 and 1988 and on the Community's successful litigation in Central Machinery Co. v. State of Arizona, 448 U.S. 160 (1980) wherein the court held that the Indian Trader Statues, 25 U.S.C. SS26 and 264, preempted the imposition of a state transaction privileges tax on sales by non-Indians to Indians; and

WHEREAS, this council is advised that the Native American Rights Fund is preparing to submit an amicus curiae brief in support of the Community's Petition and believes it to be to the benefit of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to join in such brief.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, attorneys or other appropriate officers of this Nation are authorized and directed to execute a written authorization authorizing the Native American Rights Fund to file an amicus brief on behalf of the Tohono O'Odham Nation in support of the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari filed by Central Machinery Company and the Gila River Indian Community urging the United States Supreme Court to review the decision of the Supreme Court of Arizona denying an award of attorney's fees.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1581.5 for; 58.5 against; -O- not voting; and -O- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
