

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Sif-Oidak District Revenue Sharing Budget FY '87)

RES. NO. 122-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has allocated \$13,401.00 of  
2 Federal Revenue Sharing funds to each of the eleven (11) Districts to  
3 be expended by their respective District Councils in accordance with  
4 the qualifying priorities expressed at the public hearings conducted  
5 by the District Council for such purposes; and

6 WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council has reviewed the Communities' request  
7 as expressed at such public hearing and has approved a budget for 1987  
8 Revenue Sharing funds appropriated to the Sif-Oidak District as  
9 follows:

11 \$1,340.00 to the District's Elderly Program  
12 2,680.20 to the Community of Anegam  
13 2,680.20 to the Community of Chui Chu  
14 1,340.10 to the Community of North Komelik  
15 1,340.10 to the Community of Cockleburr  
16 1,340.10 to the Community of Kohatk  
17 670.05 to the Community of Chuppo  
18 670.05 to the Community of East Chui Chu  
19 670.05 to the Community of Jackrabbit  
20 670.05 to the Community of White Horse Pass; and

21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the District's  
22 Federal Revenue Sharing budget and approves of same.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
24 it does hereby approve the foregoing allocation of the Sif-Oidak  
25 District for FY '87 Revenue Sharing funds and the attached budget and  
26 authorize expenditures in accordance therewith.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that modifications may be made when necessary to meet  
28 the needs of the District.

29 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th  
30 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
31 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
32 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
