

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Elderly Program Title III)

RES. NO. 125-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated sucessfully a program for the  
2 elderly members of the Nation; and

3 WHEREAS, funding the Elderly Program has been provided in part by Title III of  
4 the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended through the administ-  
5 ration by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and

6 WHEREAS, the Elderly Program will require continued financial assistance to  
7 continue providing minimum services to eligible clients; and

8  
9 WHEREAS, the Elderly Program has prepared a proposal for FY-88 for Title III  
10 funding to provide transportation, homecare, and other support to  
11 eligible elderly clients; and

12 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the elderly program will be beneficial to  
13 elderly clients;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it hereby  
15 approves the proposal for Title III funding for the Elderly Program to  
16 continue to provide such services it has proposed in light of the  
17 requirements and regulations


19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from July 01,  
20 1987 through June 30, 1988 unless extended by mutual agreement of both  
21 contracting parties.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that the Tohono O'Odham  
23 Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while  
24 negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has  
25 been awarded by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona.


27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-  
28 Chairman; or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
29 are hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and execute any and  
30 all contracts, amendments, and other necessary documents to secure  
31 funding for the continued operation of the Elderly Program.

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th  
2 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
3 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers  
4 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu- tion of  
5 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
6 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
7 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
8 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
