

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Law Enforcement FY '88 Budget)

RES. NO. 127-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Law Enforcement  
2 under FY 1987 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs;  
3 and  
4 WHEREAS, such Tribal operation have been successful and beneficial to the  
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and  
6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all  
7 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono  
8 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
9 termination; and  
10  
11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions  
12 of these services during FY 1988; and  
13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Law Enforce-  
14 ment contract.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
17 it does hereby authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to  
18 contract with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations  
19 and procedures for the provisions of services titled Law Enforcement.  
20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from October  
21 01, 1987 and end on September 30, 1988 unless extended by mutual  
22 agreement of both contracting parties.  
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
24 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not  
25 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to  
26 the start of the funding year.  
27  
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-  
29 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
30 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this contracts and any  
31 amendments thereto for the duration of the contract.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7th  
2 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
3 1180.0 for; 460.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
4 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
5 tion of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on  
6 January 18, 1986 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian  
7 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
8 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
