1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Community Health
2 Representative Program under FY '87 P. L. 93-638 Contract with the
3 Public Health, Indian Health Services; and

4 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract
5 shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham
6 Legislative Council; and


7 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted by the Tohono O'Odham Community Health
8 Representative Program for review and approval.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
10 hereby approve the amendment to the Tohono O'Odham Community Health
11 Representative contract.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr.; Vice-
13 Chairman and Rosita Ruiz, Acting Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham
14 Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this amendment.
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17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
18 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1398.0 for; -0- against; 242.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
21 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
