

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Workfare Demonstration Project)

RES. NO. 130-87

1 WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior has indicated that funds would be
2 available for the purpose of funding self-assistance programs such as
3 "Workfare for Indian Tribes"; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation recognizes the need for a program which
5 will foster economic independence and self sufficiency in individuals
6 and families; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham has successfully operated the Tribal Work
8 Experience Program and other work-training programs; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does desire to contract for a
10 Workfare Demonstration Project which would supplement the current
11 Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEP) not replace it; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the proposed
13 contract for the Workfare Demonstration Project; and

14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is eligible to apply for funding for a
15 Workfare Demonstration Project.


16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does
17 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract for
18 three (3) years with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638
19 regulations and procedures for the provisions of services titled:
20 Workfare Demonstration Project.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October
22 01, 1987 and end on September 30, 1988.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
25 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to
26 the start of the funding year.


27 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
28 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1577.0 for; 63.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
30 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
31 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
32 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


