
1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council reviewed the Agenda presented by the Legis-

7 Cooperative resolution as an emergency item on today's Agenda.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Agenda is

16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
19 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


