

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Air Quality and Environmental Regulations)

RES. NO. 141-87

1 WHEREAS, this Council has been informed that the Pima County Air Quality
2 Control District did serve Notice of Violation upon Mr. Cecil
3 Williams, a member of this Nation, alleging violation of state law for
4 his failure to obtain a state air quality operating permit to operate
5 a laundry within the Sells Shopping Center of the Tohono O'Odham Nation;
6 and


7 WHEREAS, the state is without jurisdiction to regulate or enforce its air
8 quality standards or state environmental laws on Indian land.

9 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the attorneys of the Nation are authorized
10 and directed to test the jurisdictional issues underlying the actions
11 or threatened actions of the Pima County Air Quality Control District
12 against Mr. Cecil Williams.
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
14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Natural Resources Committee review existing and
15 needed environmental laws and alternatives for or affecting this Nation
16 and report its recommendations to this Council.
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18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th
19 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers
21 vested in the Council by Section 1 (i) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
22 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
