
1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council reviewed and approved the Agenda for their

4 April 10, 1987 meeting.


5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that

16 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




