

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham Children's Home )

RES. NO. 145-87

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'Odham  
2 Children's Home Program under FY 1987 P.L. 93-638 contract with the  
3 Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- 4 WHEREAS, such Tribal operation have been successful and beneficial to the  
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and
- 6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all  
7 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono  
8 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
9 termination; and

- 11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions of  
12 these services during FY 1988; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Tohono  
14 O'Odham Children's Home Program Contract.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does auth-  
16 orize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the  
17 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for  
18 the provisions of services titled: Tohono O'Odham Children's Home  
19 Program.

- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a  
22 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October  
24 1, 1987 and end on September 30, 1988.
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
26 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not  
27 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to  
28 the start of the funding year.

- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr. Vice-  
31 Chairman; or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are

hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any  
amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided however  
that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 29th  
day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
1555.5 for; -0- against; 84.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers  
vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,  
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs  
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
