

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Drug issue be added on to this weeks Council Agenda)

RES. NO. 14-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is aware that a vehicle bearing
2 a possible PTUA emblem was apprehended; and
3 WHEREAS, a load of marijuana was confiscated; and
4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is concerned because of the
5 media coverage this incident has received; and
6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is opposed to smuggling of
7 drugs and narcotics which are dangerous to the health of the Nation's
8 members; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council would like to have a report re-
11 garding this matter.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Agencies involved with the apprehension
13 of a water truck bearing emblems of PTUA shall give a report to the
14 Legislature regarding the confiscation of marijuana.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
16 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1461.0 for; -0- against; 63.0 not voting; and 116.0 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
19 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
20 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
22 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


