

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution & Family Nutrition Services)

RES. NO. 151-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated successfully a program whereby
2 the diet and nutritional needs of eligible Tohono O'Odham people have
3 been served by supplementing other federal social service programs;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution/Family Nutrition
6 Services has been provided through the United States Department of
7 Agriculture; and

8 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Food Distribution Program is essential
9 to provide basic diet and nutrition for eligible clients.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it hereby
11 approves the application for continued funding of the Tohono O'Odham
12 Food Distribution/Family Nutrition Services from the United States
13 Department of Agriculture.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a
15 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from October 1,
17 1987 through September 30, 1988 unless extended by mutual agreement of
18 both contracting parties;

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that the Tohono O'Odham
20 Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while nego-
21 tiations are still being conducted and no executed Grant has been
22 awarded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
24 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, are hereby authorized to apply
25 for, and negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments and
26 other documents necessary to secure funding for the continued operation
27 of the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution Program.


28 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 29th
29 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
30 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers
31 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
32 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,

1 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
2 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
3 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




