

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Equal Employment Opportunity Commission)

RES. NO. 152-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights
2 Office since 1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono
3 O'odham people; and

4 WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office
5 has been supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission;

8 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is
9 essential to eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior
10 boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office has submitted required statistical
12 reports on a timely basis and has met the criteria for future funding.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it hereby
14 approves the continued funding for the Tribal Employment Rights Office
15 from the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that approved budget is subject to change once a
17 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from October 01,
20 1987 through September 30, 1988.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
22 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation are
23 hereby authorized to apply for, and negotiate and execute any and all
24 contracts, amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts,
25 provided however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding
26 levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval
27 by this Council.


29 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29th

31 1555.5 for; -0- against; 84.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers
32 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).


