

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Alcoholism Program)

RES. NO. 154-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Alcoholism
2 Program under FY 87 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Public Health,
3 Indian Helath Service; and

4 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
7 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted for approval to
8 the Tohono O'odham Council at least 120 days prior to the contract
9 termination; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for provisions of
11 these services during FY 1988; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Alcoholism
13 Program contract.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
15 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to
16 contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations
17 and procedures for the provision of services titled: Alcoholism
18 Program.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a
21 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will commence on
23 October 01, 1987 through September 30, 1988.


24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
25 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
26 been negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service prior to
27 the start of the funding year.


28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
29 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation
30 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and

however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by
this Council.




