

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham WIC Program)


RES. NO. 155-87

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for
2 women, infants and children during fiscal year 87; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United
4 States Department of agriculture for programs designed to benefit
5 women, infants and children; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has contracted with the Inter-Tribal Council
7 of Arizona for funds to operate and fund its women, infants and
8 children (WIC) program; and
- 9
- 10 WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients has been beneficial and
11 services continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health
12 risks and improve the health of individuals at risk.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it hereby
14 approves the application for funding from the Inter-Tribal Council
15 of Arizona, to continue to operate and provide services to eligible
16 women, infants and children.

- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a
19 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will commence on October
21 01, 1987 through September 30, 1988 unless extended by mutual a-
22 greement of both parties.
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
24 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
25 been negotiated and executed by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona
26 prior to the start of the funding year.

- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
29 Chariman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation
30 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and
31 any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided
32 however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels


1 of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
2 Council.

3 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29th
4 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
5 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers
6 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
7 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).




