

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Management of Health Services)

RES. NO. 156-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Management of  
2 Health Services Program under FY '87 P. L. 93-638 contract with the  
3 Public Health, Indian Health Service; and

4 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the  
5 Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all  
7 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono  
8 O'odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
9 termination; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to recontract for provisions of  
12 these services during FY 1988; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Management of  
14 Health Services contract.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does  
16 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to  
17 contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations  
18 and procedures for the provision of services titled: Management of  
19 Health Services Program.  
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21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a  
22 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will commence on  
24 October 1, 1987, through September 30, 1988, unless extended by mutual  
25 agreement of both parties.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate  
28 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not  
29 been negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service prior to the  
30 start of the funding year.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-  
32 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any


1 amendments thereto for the duration of the contract, provided however  
2 that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
3 contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
4 Council.

5 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29th  
6 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
7 1375.0 for; 85.0 against; 180.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
8 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
9 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
10 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
11 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
12 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



27 either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


