

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Community Health Representative)

RES. NO. 157-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Community Health  
2 Representative Program under FY '87 P. L. 93-638 contract with the  
3 Public Health, Indian Health Services; and  
4 WHEERAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the  
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and  
6 WHEREAS, 25 CRF Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all  
7 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono  
8 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
9 termination; and  
10  
11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Community  
12 Health Representative contract.  
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does  
14 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to con-  
15 tract with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-639 regulations  
16 and procedures for the provision of services titled: Community Health  
17 Representative.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a  
20 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.  
21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will commence on  
22 October 01, 1987 through September 30, 1988 unless extended by mutual  
23 agreement of both parties.  
24  
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
26 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not  
27 been negotiated and execute by the Indian Health Service prior to the  
28 start of the funding year.  
29  
30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-  
31 Chairman; or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is  
32 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any  
amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided however

1 that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
2 contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
3 Council.

4 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29th  
5 day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
6 1497.0 for; -0- against; 143.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
7 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
8 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
9 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
10 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
11 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
