WHEREAS, the Nation desires to utilize the capabilities of the administrative fiscal, support, human resource and patient services systems of Tucson Medical Center in order to more efficiently operate health care services in order to promote and maintain the delivery of high-quality health services to the members of the Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby endorses and recommends approval of the Affiliation Agreement between the Tohono O'Odham Nation and Tucson Medical Center.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  $\underline{30th}$  day of  $\underline{April}$ ,  $\underline{1987}$ , at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  $\underline{1402.5}$  for;  $\underline{-0}$  against;  $\underline{237.5}$  not voting; and  $\underline{01}$  absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
