

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Head Start Program)


RES. NO. 159-87

- 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has recognized the importance of Head Start
2 Education and stimulation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Head Start Program to provide
4 and serve educational and pre-school learning experiences for children
5 between the ages of 3-5 years; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Department of Health & Human Services, Administration for
7 Children, Youth & Families, has provided funding for the operation of
8 the Head Start Program; and

- 10 WHEREAS, the Administration for Children, Youth & Families will provide funds
11 for the continued operation of the Head Start program to eligible and
12 qualifying applicants; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Head Start program has prepared a proposal for FY 88 program oper-
14 rations to be submitted to the Department of Health & Human Services;
15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Head Start
17 grant.

- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
20 authorize and request the Department of Health & Human Services to
21 contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation for the provision of services
22 titled: Head Start Program.
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to change once a
24 decision is made on the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) rate.
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from November
26 01, 1987 through October 31, 1988.
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- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
29 a program from which grants are requested herewith which have not
30 been negotiated and executed by the Department of Health & Human
31 Services prior to the start of the funding year.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-

Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation
are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these grants and
any amendments thereto for the duration of the grants, provided how-
ever that any amendments affecting the funding of funding levels of
the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.


The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30th
day of April, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1555.5 for; -0- against; 84.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
