



RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Council Agenda)

RES. NO. 164-87


1 WHEREAS, Harriet Toro, Chairperson of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
2 did present and review the agenda for May 1, 1987 meeting; and  
3 WHEREAS, a request from Councilwoman Rosemary Lopez was made to move Legisla-  
4 tive Rules as #8 and to move Campaign Ethics as #3.  
5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
6 hereby accepts the request to move Legislative Rules as #8 and to move  
7 Campaign Ethics as #3.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 1st  
10 day of May, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
11 548.5 for; 440.0 against; 513.5 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the  
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
13 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
14 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
15 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
16 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


