

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Papago Farming Authority Name Change)

RES. NO. 166-87

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 72-79 create and establish
2 the Papago Farming Authority pursuant to an approved Plan of
3 Operation, naming it the Papago Farming Authority; and


4 WHEREAS, the members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on January 18, 1986 adopt
5 a new constitution changing the name of the Papago Tribe to the Tohono
6 O'Odham Nation; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Farming Authority, anticipating that the Tohono O'Odham
8 Legislative Council intended also to change the name of the Authority
9 to Tohono O'Odham Farming Authority, did adopt the name Tohono O'Odham
10 Farming Authority upon its official stationary and in its dealings
11 with third parties, and now requires this Council's assent and rati-
12 fication therefore.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
15 it does hereby authorize the Papago Farming Authority to use the name
16 Tohono O'Odham Farming Authority upon its official stationary,
17 contracts, checks and bank accounts and does hereby ratify the
18 Authority's past use of the name.
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20 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 1st.
21 day of May, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
23 vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
24 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
25 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).


