

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Opposition to the Memorandum of Agreement)

RES. NO. 16-87

1 WHEREAS, the United States Congress, on October 17, 1986, enacted "The Omnibus
2 Drug Enforcement, Education and Control Act of 1986"; and
3 WHEREAS, the said Act was signed into law on October 27, 1986; and
4 WHEREAS, Title IV, Subtitle C. cited as "The Indian Alcohol and Substance Abuse
5 Prevention and Treatment Act of 1986" deals specifically with Indian
6 Tribes; and
7 WHEREAS, Title IV, Subtitle C, Section 4205 (a) specifies the development and
8 entrance into a Memorandum Agreement between the Secretary of Health
9 and Human Services and the Secretary of the Interior; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 4205 (c) states that, in developing the Memorandum of
12 Agreement the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Health
13 and Human Services shall consult with and solicit the comments of:

15 1. Interested Indian Tribes
16 2. Indian Individuals
17 3. Indian Organizations
18 4. Professionals in the treatment of alcohol and substance abuse

21 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is in opposition to the Memo-
22 randum of Agreement, signed and dated September 12, 1986 and does not
23 recognize said agreement as satisfactory to comply with the mandates
24 of Title IV, Subtitle C, Section 4205 (a) and (c).

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
27 it hereby notifies the Director of Indian Health Services and the
28 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs that the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
29 through its designate, will actively participate in the development of
30 the Memorandum of Agreement as provided for in Section 4205 (c) of the
31 Act.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c) (2) (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
