

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Bihino1 Du'ag High School Board Interim Budget)

RES. NO. 168-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the Tohono O'Odham Education Committee
2 has supported construction and planning of secondary education
3 facilities and programs for Tohono O'Odham students; and
4 WHEREAS, the Bihino1 Du'ag High School will be opening its doors to students in
5 August of 1987; and
6 WHEREAS, the School Board and Administration still have an enormous amount of
7 work that needs to be completed prior to school start up; and
8 WHEREAS, the O'Odham Education Department budget is such that it cannot
9 continue to absorb the costs incurred in program start up planning; and
10 WHEREAS, the Bihino1 Du'ag High School Board has submitted to the Human
11 Resource Development Committee and the Budget & Finance Committee a
12 budget which would allow the continuance of start up planning; and
13 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee and Human Resource Development
14 Committee has approved the budget request which will be paid out of
15 the Administrative Provision.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bihino1 Du'ag High School Board is
18 granted a six (6) week interim budget not to exceed \$8,000.

20 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 1st
21 day of May, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers
23 vested in the Council by Section 1d (2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
24 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
25 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
