

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Justice Program)

RES. NO. 170-87

1 WHEREAS, the Justice Program has been in existence since 1984 providing
2 prosecution and defense services for tribal member's and the
3 Judiciary; and

4 WHEREAS, P. L. 93-638 Self-Determination grant funds provided the base for
5 operations but because of funding cuts are not longer available; and

6 WHEREAS, prosecution and defense services are vital to both the Nation and its
7 members; and

8 WHEREAS, there is an immediate need to authorize the expenditure of tribal
9 funds for the continued operation of the program.

10 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee recommends the interim budget from
11 April to June in the amount stated in the budget attached.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Budget & Finance Committee recommenda-
13 tion given in conjunction with the Judiciary Committee is hereby
14 approved and tribal funds are authorized to be expended by the Justice
15 Program.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves the recom-
18 mendation of the Budget & Finance and Judiciary Committee.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Justice Program is authorized to expend tribal
20 funds.


22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding for the program will be from the Admin-
23 istrative Provision.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose Jr., Vice-
25 Chairman; or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are
26 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute said funds.

28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 1st
29 day of May, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
30 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers
31 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu- tion of
32 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).






