2 the Tohono O'Odham Council the projected funding amounts for FY-1989;

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council is required to establish Agency program
5 priorities and set program funding and staffing levels by using the
6 Decision Ranking Chart; and

7 WHEREAS, the Decision Ranking Chart allows the Tohono O'Odham Nation to
8 participate in the Federal Budget process and to allocate resources in
9 the most cost efficient manner which will provide maximum services and
10 benefits for its members; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed the decision units and is
12 satisfied that the following Decision Ranking Chart is appropriate:

7 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
8 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
