

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(May 23, 1987 General Election)

RES. NO. 176-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on Saturday, May 23, 1987, have a
2 general election for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the
3 Tohono O'Odham Nation and Representatives and Alternates to the Tohono
4 O'Odham Council; and

5 WHEREAS, the Election Board did issue and post its Certificates of Election
6 Results in accordance with Section 6 (E) of article VII of the Uniform
7 Election Ordinance, certifying to the election of the candidates who
8 received the highest number of votes for elective office; and

10 WHEREAS, under section 6(N) of article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance,
11 it is incumbent upon this Council to issue Certificates of Election to
12 the candidates who received the highest number of votes for each
13 office or Council seat within 20 days after the Election Board has
14 posted its Certificates of Election Results provided, however, that no
15 election contest statement has been filed against the candidates
16 within the time allowed and provided for, and provided further that
17 they hold no other elective office of the nation.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairperson and Secretary of the Tohono
20 O'Odham Council are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the
21 Council to execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to the
22 following persons elected either at large as Chairman and Vice Chairman
23 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, or from their respective Districts as
24 Representatives and Alternates to the Tohono O'Odham Council, who shall
25 hold offices for a term of four (4) years and until their successors
26 are certified and seated, to-wit:


