

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Police Protection for San Lucy District)

RES. NO. 18-87

1 WHEREAS, the San Lucy Legislative Representative did submit San Lucy District
2 Resolution No. 36-86 to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
3 requesting police protection; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does acknowledge the need to
5 provide police protection for the people of San Lucy; and

6 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee under the Legislative Branch is
7 empowered to oversee and set policies regarding such protection; and


8 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee must take an active role in seeking
9 means of granting the request for San Lucy.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
12 hereby direct the Domestic Affairs Committee to meet with the Chief of
13 police to discuss better law enforcement for the people of San Lucy.


14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the alternative to be considered is the establish-
15 ment of a Station in that district.

17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
18 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
20 vested in the Council by Section 1 c (2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
21 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
22 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
23 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
24 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


