(Seniority Preference requested by John Reno)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 189-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did act on retaining current  
2 members of the Commerce Committee under the Legislative Branch; and

3 WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee does have vacancies due to the resignation of  
4 members of the Legislative Branch and in other cases members were not  
5 re-elected; and


6 WHEREAS, under the Legislative Rules ARTICLE XII ELECTION OF LEGISLATIVE  
7 OFFICERS AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS, SECTION 3.C. seniority preference  
8 appointment can be invoked by Legislative members meeting this  
9 criteria; and

11 WHEREAS, San Lucy District representative, John Reno, did invoke this clause by  
12 filing his candidacy for the Commerce Committee based on seniority.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does  
14 hereby appoint John Reno to the Commerce Committee based on ARTICLE  
15 XII ELECTION OF LEGISLATIVE OFFICERS TO COMMITTEE MEMBERS, SECTION  
16 3.C., Seniority Preference Appointment.

18 The foregoing Legislative Order was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on  
19 the 3rd day of June, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
20 vote of 736.5 for; 775.0 against; 128.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to  
21 the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) & (b) of Article VI of the  
22 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
