LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 190-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did establish a committee
2 entitled Cultural Preservation Committee; and

4 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee has jurisdiction over
5 archeological and culturally related issues; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council Legislative Rules allows
8 appointment to any of its committee based on ARTICLE XII SECTION 3.
9 ELECTION OF MEMBERS, LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES, C. SENIORITY PREFERENCE
10 APPOINTMENT; and

12 WHEREAS, Council representatives, Cross Antone from Gu Vo District, Fernando
13 Joaquin from Gu Achi District, Henry Ramon from Hickiwan District,
14 Johnson Jose from Pisinemo District and Kenneth Chico, Sr. from
15 Baboquivari District has requested appointment to the Cultural
16 Preservation Committee based on seniority.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
19 hereby appoint the following members of the Council based on Seniority
20 Preference, ARTICLE XII SECTION 3.C. of the Legislative Rules:

3. Henry Ramon - Hickiwan District
4. Johnson Jose - Pisinemo District
5. Kenneth Chico, Sr. - Baboquivari District

25 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
26 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution
27 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
28 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
29 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
30 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


