

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Disposition of Accounting Records)

RES. NO. 200-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Accounting Office did submit a list of old
2 records dating back to 1966 which was inventoried and separated and
3 currently stored in the Record Retention Building; and


4 WHEREAS, it is their recommendation that these records be destroyed; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council would like to refer this matter
6 to the Rules and Budget & Finance Committees.


7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the matter of disposition of Accounting
8 records be referred to the Rules Committee who will take the lead in
9 conjunction with the Budget & Finance Committee for recommendations to
10 the Legislature.

12 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd.
13 day of June, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
14 1198.5 for; 372.5 against; 69.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
19 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


