

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Sif Oidak District Budget Amendment FY '87)

RES. NO. 201-87

1 WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council recognizes a need for new vehicles to
2 replace the old vehicles due to the safety conditions; and

3 WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council voted in favor of looking into three
4 (3) vehicles: 2 vans and 1 mini wagon at their January 17th meeting;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, bids were obtained on the said vehicles through the office of Mr. John
7 Couzins; and

8 WHEREAS, an amendment of \$44,276.10 would be necessary to the existing budget
9 of \$163,674.47 making it a total of \$207,950.57 for the FY 1987
10 District budget; and


11 WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council has sufficient funds in its IIM account
12 to cover the amended amount.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it
14 does hereby approve the purchase of three (3) vehicles.


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does

24 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
25 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
