

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(San Lucy Fire Protection Agreement)

RES. NO. 20-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation entered into a agreement with the Town of
2 Gila Bend, a copy of which is attached hereto, wherein the Town of
3 Gila Bend agreed to provide fire protection to the village of San Lucy
4 at a yearly cost of \$75.00 per primary unit with 77 units presently
5 situated in San Lucy village or a total cost of \$5,775.00 per year
6 ;and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council did pass a resolution authorizing the
8 renewal of this agreement for a one year period commencing July 1,
9 1986, and the Town Council of Gila Bend notified the Nation of its
10 acceptance of said renewal; and

11 WHEREAS, the Gila Bend Town Council notified the San Lucy District Council in
12 writing that the District was in jeopardy of losing its fire
13 protection due to the failure of timely payment of costs as set forth
14 in its agreement with the town of Gila Bend and that the agreement
15 must be amended to provide for interest on all late payments; and

16 WHEREAS, the letter also provided that unless this proposed amendment was
17 accepted by the Nation within 60 days of the date of said letter,
18 the letter would serve as notice of cancellation of the agreement, a
19 copy of said letter is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

20 WHEREAS, if this fire protection agreement is cancelled, the village of San
21 Lucy would be left without any means of protecting its people and
22 property from fire destruction; and

23 WHEREAS, to eliminate this problem, it would be in the best interest of the
24 Nation and the San Lucy District if the payment of cost for the fire
25 protection is prepaid annually.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
27 it does hereby authorize the modification of the existing San Lucy
28 District fire protection agreement with the Town of Gila Bend to

1 provide for the prepayment of all costs remaining payable under the
2 terms of the existing agreement and in the event of any renewals of
3 said agreement, the costs shall be prepaid annually.

4 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
5 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
6 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers
7 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) 2 & 3 of Article VI of the Constitution
8 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
9 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
10 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
11 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
