WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'Odham Nation entered into a agreement with the Town of
	Gila Bend, a copy of which is attached hereto, wherein the Town of
	Gila Bend agreed to provide fire protection to the village of San Lucy
	at a yearly cost of \$75.00 per primary unit with 77 units presently
	situated in San Lucy village or a total cost of \$5,775.00 per year
	; and
WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'Odham Council did pass a resolution authorizing the
	renewal of this agreement for a one year period commencing July 1,
	1986, and the Town Council of Gila Bend notified the Nation of its
	acceptance of said renewal; and
WHEREAS,	the Gila Bend Town Council notified the San Lucy District Council in
	writing that the District was in jeopardy of losing its fire
	protection due to the failure of timely payment of costs as set forth
	in its agreement with the town of Gila Bend and that the agreement
	must be amended to provide for interest on all late payments; and
WHEREAS,	the letter also provided that unless this proposed amendment was
	accepted by the Nation within 60 days of the date of said letter,
	the letter would serve as notice of cancellation of the agreement, a
	copy of said letter is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and
WHEREAS,	if this fire protection agreement is cancelled, the village of San
	Lucy would be left without any means of protecting its people and
ti sentes	property from fire destruction; and
WHEREAS,	to eliminate this problem, it would be in the best interest of the
	Nation and the San Lucy District if the payment of cost for the fire
	protection is prepaid annually.
NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
	it does hereby authorize the modification of the existing San Lucy
	District fire protection agreement with the Town of Gila Bend to
