

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide sufficient
funding for the Tohono O'Odham High School)

RES. NO. 235-87

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs did not complete all promised con-
2 struction at the Tohono O'Odham High School (i.e., lighting,
3 sprinkling system for the Athletic Field, six additional staff houses,
4 and residential cottages for ninety-six (96) students; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Board, through its Administrator, had requested
7 five hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$570,000.00) in start-up funds
8 and was granted only three hundred fifty thousand dollars
9 (\$350,000.00) by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

10 WHEREAS, the start-up monies received were insufficient to purchase the number
11 of library books necessary to meet Bureau and North Central
12 Accreditation Association standards; and



14 WHEREAS, the start-up monies received were insufficient to purchase equipment
15 (tractors, plows, etc.) and materials necessary for an effective
16 agricultural education program.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs provide the
18 funds necessary to complete the above construction projects and
19 start-up costs for the Tohono O'Odham High School.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Enos Francisco Jr., Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham
21 Nation and Angelo Joaquin, Sr., Vice-Chairman are hereby directed to
22 work with the appropriate Bureau officials in the identification and
23 procurement of the necessary funding.

25 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th.
26 day of July, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
27 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
28 vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
29 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
